

## **CITATION AND CROSS-CITATION RULES IN THE NOVA EKONOMIJA PROCEEDINGS**

(AUTHOR GUIDELINES)

These rules establish the principles of citation and cross-citation in papers published in the *Nova Ekonomija* Proceedings, with the aim of preserving academic integrity, preventing misuse, and fostering relevant scientific dialogue.

The citation of other works must be based solely on the scholarly justification and contribution of the cited source to the research topic. Authors are free to cite any relevant sources, including works from previous issues of the *Nova Ekonomija* Proceedings or related publications, when such citations contribute to the quality and soundness of the paper.

Including citations solely for the purpose of increasing the citation count of certain authors, journals, or publications is not permitted. Such a practice is considered contrary to the ethical principles of scholarly publishing.

The use of a variety of sources from relevant domestic and international publications is recommended to ensure the breadth and objectivity of the scientific approach. Cited sources must be verified, accessible, and properly referenced in accordance with the *Nova Ekonomija* Proceedings' adopted citation style.

These rules apply to all papers submitted for publication, and compliance with them is mandatory during the peer review and editorial approval process.
